Level of Hike:

Difficult and challenging. Participants must be adept and fit walkers and of good health as the route is not developed and the terrain presents many obstacles. There are no developed trails and this is a scrambling route with uneven ground, loose rock, some dense vegetation and will have slippery and steep conditions. Also we are in rattlesnake habitat. *All participants will be required to agree to the stated conditions and must sign a waiver.*

Hike Highlights:

We will experience a myriad of badlands and hoodoo habitats. We will scramble through side canyons and see unique outcrops, rock art, and historical inscriptions. We may also see fossils, petrified wood, and wildlife.

Bus will transport participants to the hiking site

12:30pm Lunch. Provided by MRWCC

4pm Back to Milk River. The tour will be approximately 6 hours and 8 km

What to Bring: All participants must wear proper hiking gear and have enough drinking water for rehydration. Water and snacks will be provided by MRWCC
