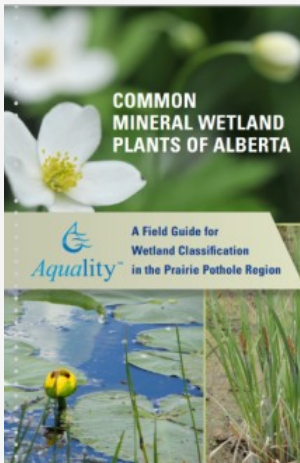


2018 ALBERTA WETLAND COURSES
